Plum Creek Contributed \$85,800 to Community Organizations in Maine During 2006

FAIRFIELD, Maine – Plum Creek provided more than \$85,800 in financial support to dozens of community organizations across Maine in 2006.

The Plum Creek Foundation contributed grants to 10 non-profit programs. The company also provided additional community support through other non-foundation sources, including a program that matches employee volunteer hours and individual contributions to local, qualified non-profit organizations. Each year, Plum Creek and its employees also support the local United Way campaign. During 2006, Maine employees' donations to local campaigns, with a match from the Plum Creek Foundation, totaled \$20,920. United Way distributed these funds to a variety of non-profit organizations in Maine.
